









What is "Advent"? - It means "arrival" or "coming into place" It's marked by the themes of hope, peace, joy, and love






All the busyness, shopping, and ads during Christmas can dull our heart and dilute our senses to the astonishing act of God becoming flesh.












Who is Emperor Augustus? - He was the grandnephew and adopted son of Julius Caesar - He ruled from 30 B.C. - A.D. 14 - He established loyal, local kings to help him. Thus, King Herod (Matthew 2:1) ruled in Israel. - Issued a heavy tax on people






Who is Emperor Augustus?

- With King Herod's oversight, he supported the rebuilding of the Second Temple in Jerusalem - He recognized the importance of religious autonomy and so he allowed the Jews to continue their religious traditions and practices



When this season centers on the portrayal of a cute baby Jesus, it fosters a church that is subdued, tamed, and domesticated.






Essential Qualities of the Gospel



5. Replete (John 14:16-17; Ephesians 3:19, 5:18; Colossians 2:9-10)


3. Righteous (Leviticus 26:12; Romans 3:22; Philippians 3:9; Romans 1:16-17)
