1. Who is the Holy Spirit?

- * He is God. (Matthew 28:19, 2 Corinthians 13:14)
- * He is a person. (1 Corinthians 12:11)
- * **He indwells.** (John 20:22, 1 Corinthians 3:16, Ephesians 1:13-14)
- * He comes upon. (Luke 24:49, Acts 1:8, 2:1-4)

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2. What is His role in prayer?

- a. To strengthen the weak. (Romans 8:26)
- b. To make wise the ignorant. (Romans 8:26)
- c. To make useful the ineffective. (Romans 8:27)

 - Corinthians 10:13)
- g. Complete Armor of God (Ephesians 6:18)
