Action #1: Repent

- John the Baptist, Jesus, and the New Testament writers preached about repentance. (Matthew 3:2, 4:17, Acts 2:38, 17:30, 26:20; Revelation 2:5, 16:9,11) - Repent means a "sincere change of heart and mind".

God's kindness and sorrow leads a person to repentance. (Romans 2:4; 2 Corinthians 7:10)



- Repentance enables us to live under God's grace and life. (Acts 11:18; 2 Corinthians 7:10)

- Repentance is "Goodness-of-God-focused", and not "sin-focused". (Acts 3:19, 20:21, 26:20)

- Pride, lust, greed, power, control, and recognition rejects humility and surrender of repentance. (Proverbs 16:18; 1 Timothy 6:9-10)
