(n.) Abundantly giving; Freedom from meanness, smallness of mind or character.



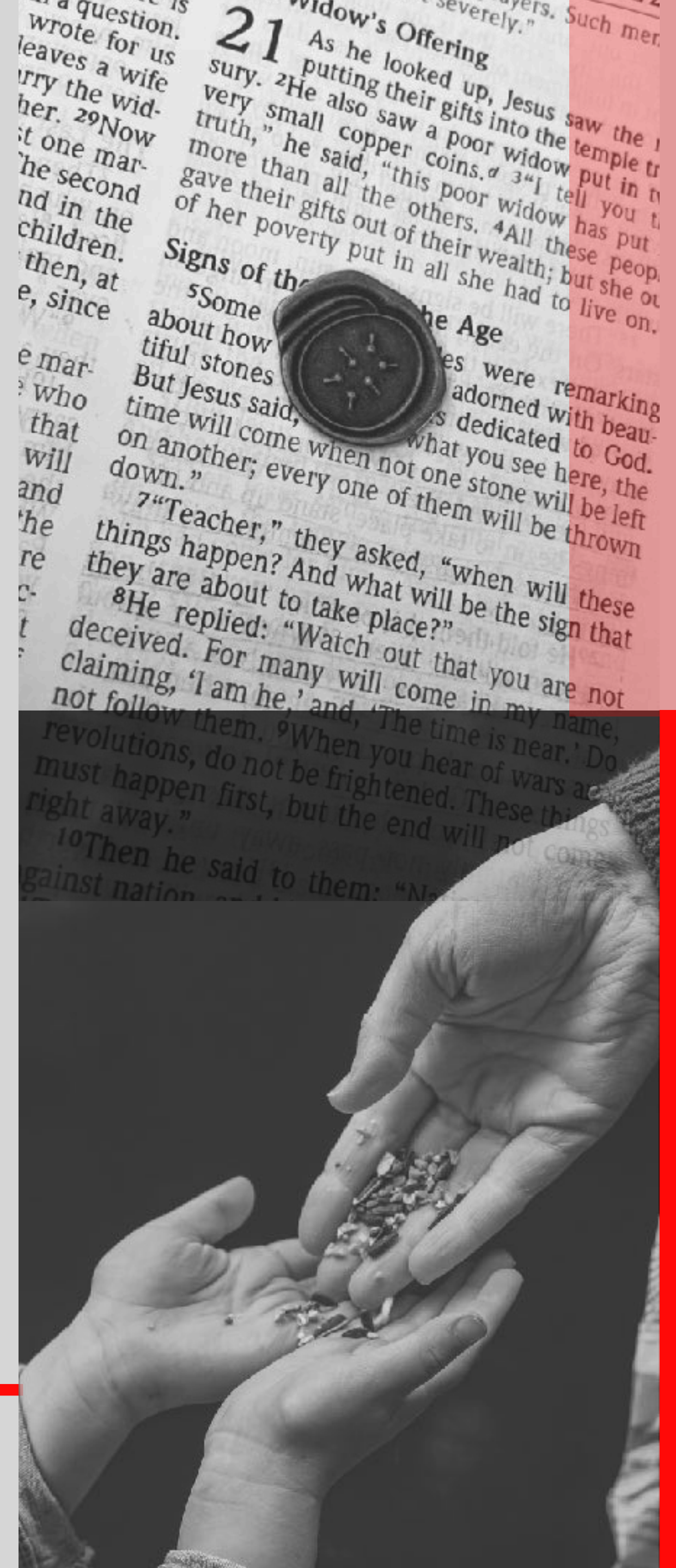
I hope we will be radically generous people who faithfully witness our trust in Jesus and His loving, generous disposition.

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“Stop being deceived.”

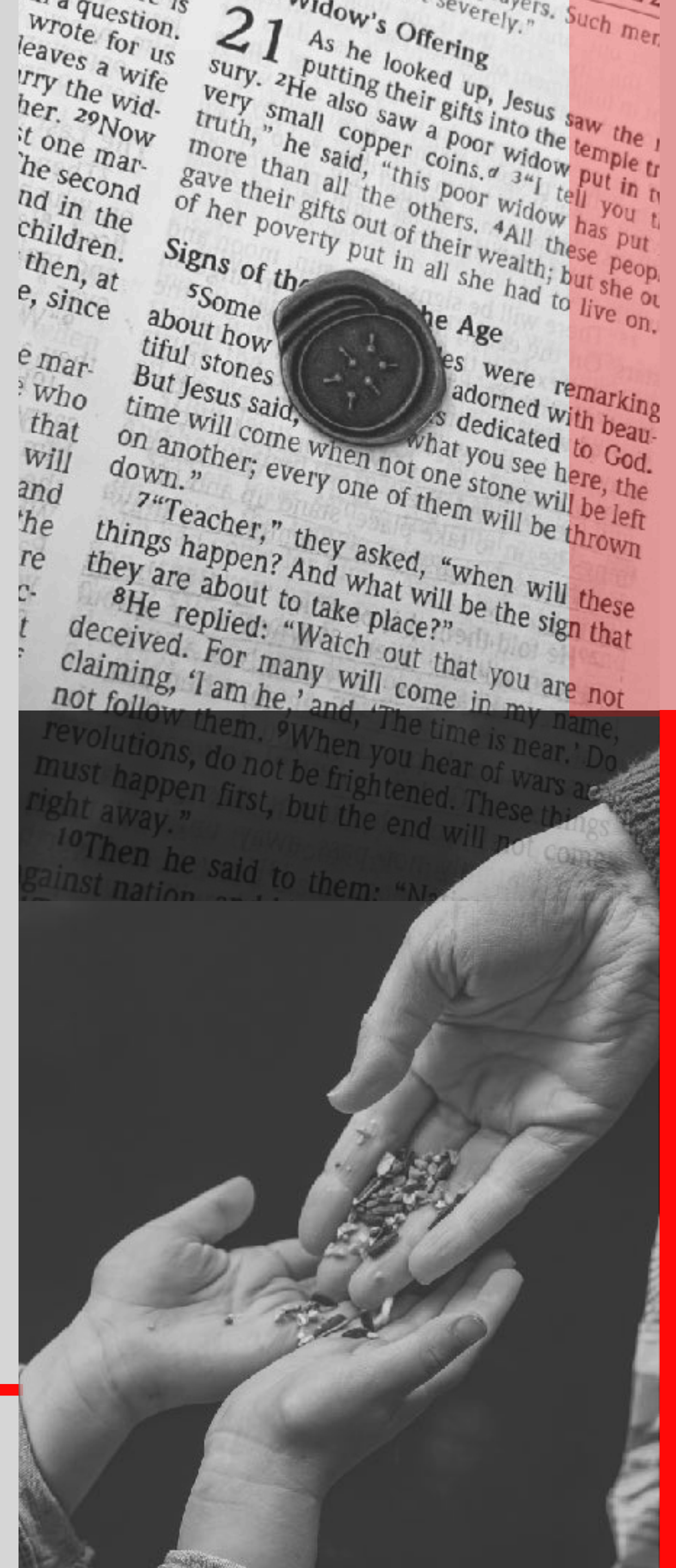

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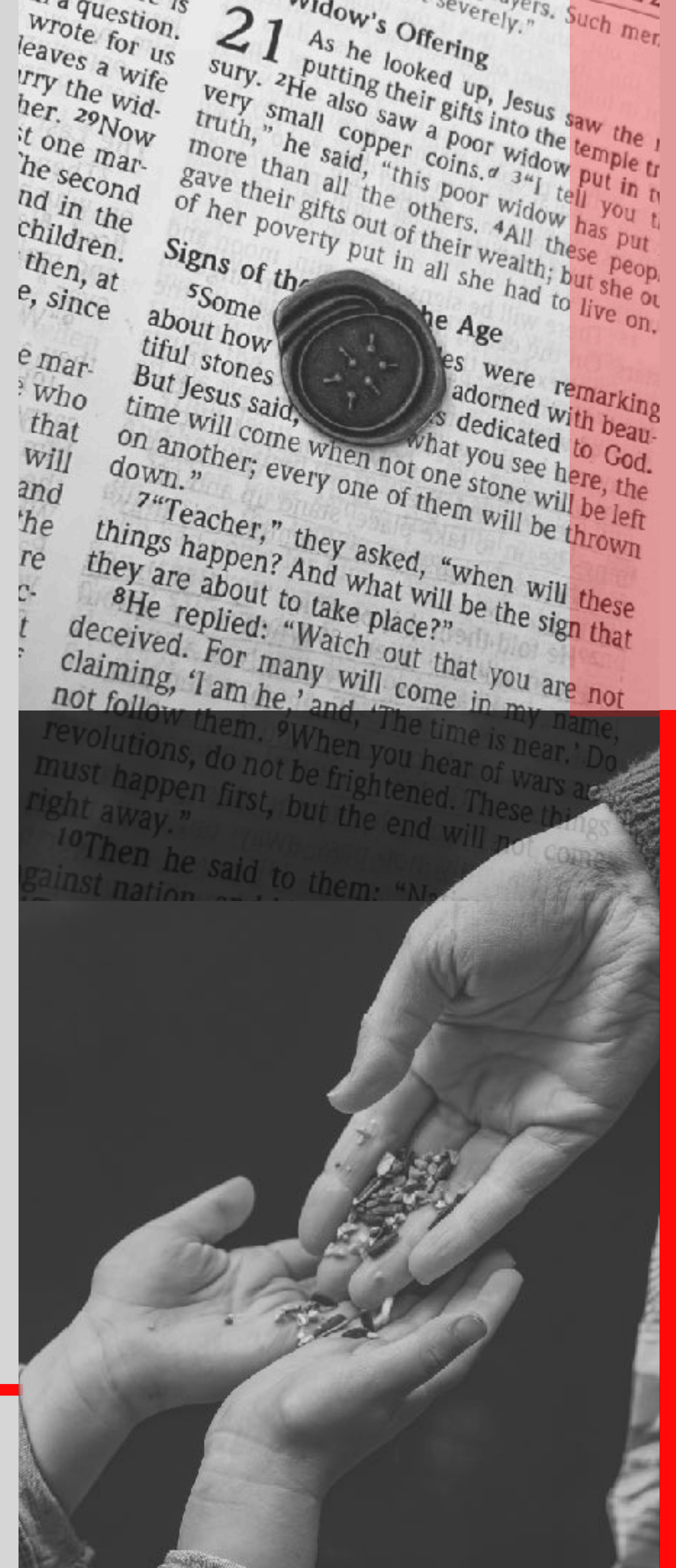

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Types of a Generosity / Giving:

1. Tithe (*Leviticus 27:30, Matthew 23:23*)



“What sorrow awaits you teachers of religious law and you Pharisees. Hypocrites! For you are careful to *tithe* with even the tiniest income from your herb gardens, but you ignore the more important aspects of the law — justice, mercy, and faith. *You should tithe*, yes, but do not neglect the more important things.”

Types of a Generosity / Giving:

1. Tithe (*Leviticus 27:30, Matthew 23:23*)
2. Offering (*Exodus 35:5, Deuteronomy 16:10, 2 Corinthians 9:2, 1 Corinthians 9:11-12*)
3. First Fruits (*Deuteronomy 14:22*)
4. Alms (*Matthew 6:4*)
- *5. Grace Giving (*2 Corinthians 8 & 9*)

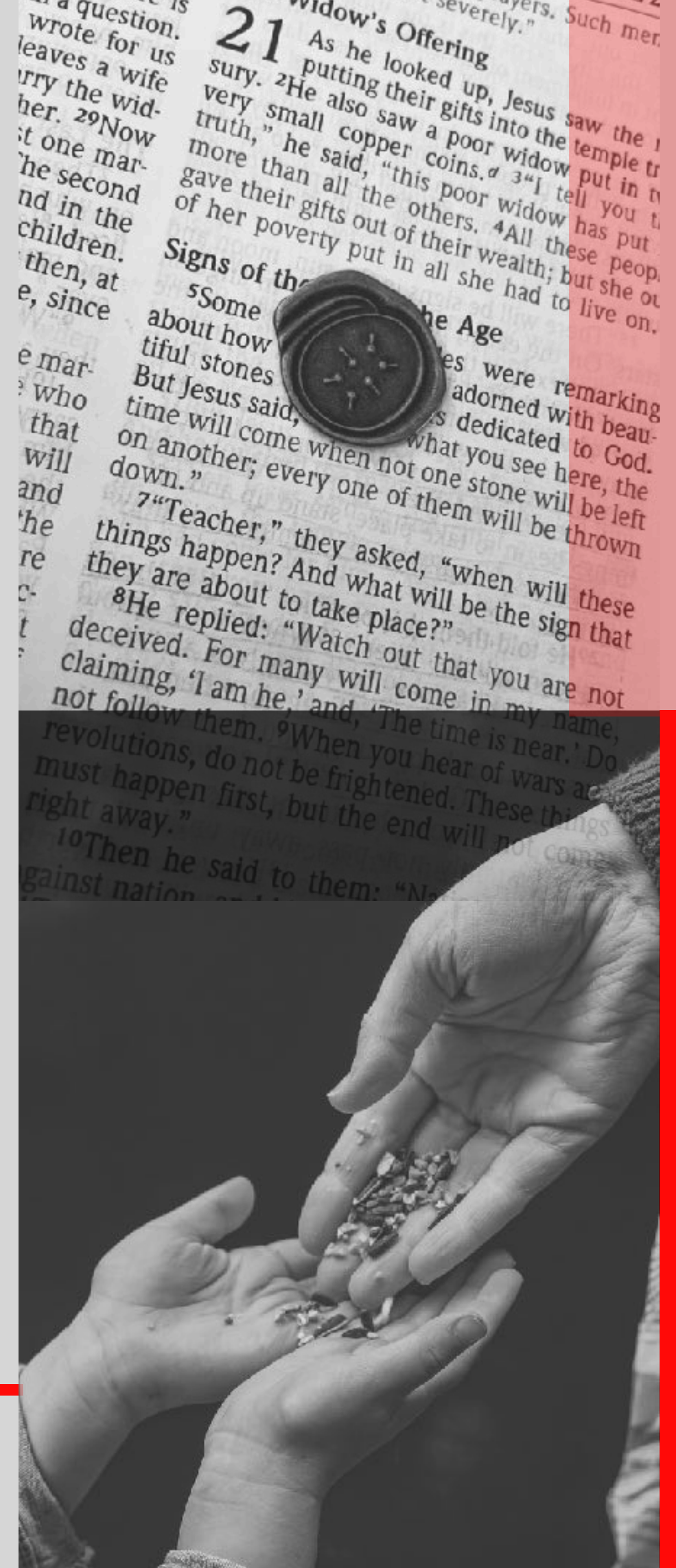
