

Officials: Two killed, one injured in Williamson County shooting

Two people were killed and another was injured in a fight between neighbors that escalated into a shooting early Sunday in Williamson County, according to the sheriff's office.

Detectives on Sunday were still piecing together the details of the shooting, which occurred about 12:30 a.m. Sunday at a home in the 600 block of Kathleen Lane near U.S. 183 and Crystal Falls Parkway.

Kimberly Tervin, 40, and her neighbor, Ronald Berry, 45, both died of apparent gunshot wounds inside the house, sheriff's officials said.

Tervin's husband, Forest Tervin, 45, was taken to an area hospital with two gunshot wounds, which were considered non-life threatening, officials said.

Janis Stover, who lives next to the Tervins, said the couple was having a typical weekend get-together. Music was playing and people had been laughing since about dusk, she said.

Then around 12:32 a.m., the 72-year-old heard four gunshots, a pause, and then another four gunshots.

What I learned about Participation and Pronouncement:

- 3. Jesus is in the pain of others. You have to get close to the pain to see Him.

How can I take responsibility for this message?

- 1. Pray for open doors to share and to discern who is receptive.
- 2. Write your testimony and practice sharing it in 3 minutes or less.
- 3. Look for your neighbor and engage.
- 4. Do something kind for your literal neighbor and have no expectation of response, reciprocation, or recognition.
