In life, we often find common ground in recognizing that situations have a greater purpose beyond what we see at first glance.

Our initial reactions to what we experience can prevent us from responding in helpful ways that address the greater purpose.

# HANDS AND HEARTS FROM WITHERED TO WHOLE

This story teaches us that there are two ways to live. The first is to be one with God, be and act like Him, and show His love and power. The second is acting like we're good and righteous, but in reality, we're stubborn and hard-hearted inside.

#### TWO ESSENTIAL TRUTHS:

- 1. "Withered" literally means "dry" or "parched"; a loss of vitality
- 2. "Right hand" symbolizes:
  - a. Power for living
  - b. Blessing
  - c. Healing


