- 5. Self-sufficiency (The answer: 1 Cor 15:10; 2 Cor 12:9)

What are the enemies of our confidence?

- 6. Spiritual Warfare (The answer: Eph 6:13-19)
 - a. Put on the whole armor of King Jesus.
 - b. Stand.
 - c. Pray in the Spirit.
 - d. Pray for others and the advancement of the gospel.
