John 14:12, 2 Corinthians 1:21-22, 1 John 2:20,27

All of us are anointed. It's not reserved for a special group of people.

What is the anointing?

The presence of the Holy Spirit setting us apart and giving us a divine enablement to fulfill His purpose.

Why are we anointed?

To bring glory to God by faithfully obeying Him in our calling and purpose.

- 1. To witness. (Acts 1:8)
- 2. To do good. (Romans 12:9, 21)
- **3. To do greater things.** (John 14:12)
- 4. To disciple others. (Matthew 28:18-20)





Facets of the Anointing

- 1. God's anointing does not keep us from sinning. (1 Samuel 15:1, 9, 13-15, 17-19, 24)
- 2. God's anointing is given by God and therefore, God can take it away. (1 Samuel 15:1, 17, 24; 16:1, 14)
