


My pastoral concern is that our understanding and experience of God's love is too small, resulting in a life fashioned more by disappointments, discouragements, and passivity.




My pastoral hope is that through renewing our mind and the reality of God's love touching our hearts, we will:






## Three questions to discuss with a friend:

1. Do we need the reality of evil, sin, and death as our motivator for a relationship with God the Father, or is the beauty of God's love for us enough?




