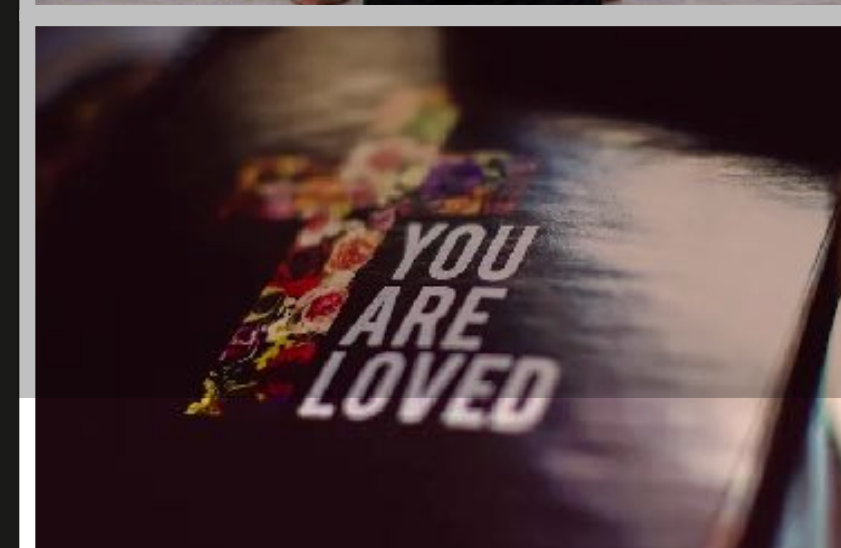
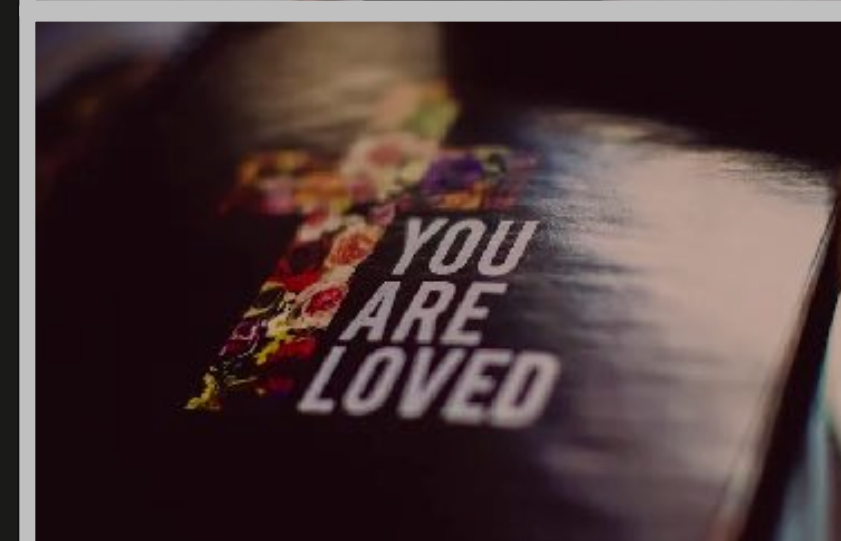
The subject of righteousness is of major importance to Jesus and to living the “livable life of God”.
