

### We are made to find our deepest joy and greatest satisfaction not from doing whatever we want, but by surrendering to God's will.






### We are NOT saved by good works. We are saved FOR good works.

  - His <u>PROGRESSIVE</u> commitment








### 2. Function (good works) Genesis 1:26-28










### 2. Function (good works)

### 3. Fruitfulness (walk in them) John 15:5, 8, 16; 17:4










### How can we participate with this message?
