CHANGE

An event; a moment in time

TRANSITION

An emotional, spiritual, relational, psychological process before, during, and after a change

External

Internal

CHANGE

Examples: job loss, marriage, new home, graduation, entering kindergarten, change in health, new boss

TRANSITION

Examples: surprise, confusion, anger, relief, vulnerability, hopefulness, disillusioned, clarity

Not always controllable

We can surrender to God and cooperate with our growth and how we respond to change

- Transition involves three phases:
 - 1. Departure
 - 2. Disorientation
 - 3. Destination

- God initiates a change that launches transition.

"HANGING ON" HAS BECOME ENTERTAINMENT:



- Common emotions during transition:
 - 1. Fear (1 John 4:18)
 - 2. Loss/Sadness (Romans 12:15)
 - 3. Confusion (Proverbs 3:5-6)
 - 4. Anger (Romans 15:13)
 - 5. Shock (James 1:5)
